

Requirements and Guidelines

Summary

Application Deadline	November 2, 2025
Eligibility Requirements	Open to pianists, strings, winds, brass and percussionists. Students in grades 9- 12 are eligible (including those who graduate Winter 2025).
	No restrictions on residential location but must be able to attend rehearsals in Santa Clarita, as directed.
Audition Requirements	Audition pieces must be less than 12 minutes in length (may be more than one movement). Judges will select excerpts to perform at time of audition.
	Auditioner should provide their own accompanist, if needed, and 3 copies of the music to provide to judges.
Audition Information	Location: Santa Clarita United Methodist Church 26640 Bouquet Canyon Rd, Santa Clarita, CA Date: November 15, 2025 (1:00 pm – 7:00 pm) Contestants will be organized into three (3) groups according to instrument – piano, strings, winds/brass/percussion. One winner from each group will be selected by a panel of judges to perform their concerto with SCSO in March. Winners will receive a professional recording of their piece as performed in the concert and a plaque.

Applicants will receive an assigned audition time (approx. 15 mins) via email after applications are processed.
